More than 1,000 Protestors hand deliver message to Ford

On May 19, 2010, more than 1,000 members and friends of Citizens for Clean Air (C4CA) marched and chanted their way to Ford's Oakville assembly plant to demand that Ford show community support by funding an individual environmental assessment (IEA) for the proposed Oakville Generating Station.



The large group met at Kingsford Gardens and made their way to the plant chanting, "Do the right thing Ford, Do the right thing McQuinty!" and "We deserve an IEA!"
